AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE IN SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND THE ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section two of chapter twenty of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the second sentence therein and in-  
3 serting the following:—The commissioner shall receive a  
4 salary not exceeding twenty-two thousand dollars, as the Gov-  
5 ernor may determine, and traveling expenses incurred in the  
6 performance of his official duties and shall devote his full  
7 time during business hours to the duties of his office.

8 Section five of said chapter twenty is hereby amended by  
9 striking out said section five and inserting the following:—

10 The assistant commissioner of the department of agriculture  
11 shall receive such salary not exceeding sixteen thousand dol-  
12 lars, as the Governor may determine, and traveling expenses  
13 incurred in the performance of his official duties and shall  
14 devote his full time during business hours to the duties of his  
15 office.
