AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON MAY EMPLOY LEGAL COUNSEL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after Section 37B the following section: —
- 3 *Section 37C.* Notwithstanding the fact that the City of
- 4 Boston has employed legal counsel under the provisions of
- 5 paragraph fifteen, sixteen or sixteen A of section five of
- 6 chapter 40, the school committee of the City of Boston may
- 7 expend money from funds appropriated for school purposes
- 8 for the employment of other counsel for the general purposes
- 9 of said committee.
