AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF RANDOLPH TO PAY A PENSION TO EDWARD F. FAHEY, A FORMER TOWN ACCOUNTANT OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good
2 and in consideration of long and meritorious service, the
3 Town of Randolph is hereby authorized to pay a pension of
4 Two Thousand Dollars per annum to Edward F. Fahey, a
5 former town accountant of said town.
