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SENATE, January 24, 1967.

1 *Ordered*, That a special committee to consist of five mem-  
2 bers of the Senate to be appointed by the president is hereby  
3 established for the purpose of making an investigation and  
4 study of all the port facilities under the jurisdiction and con-  
5 trol of the Massachusetts Port Authority, with particular  
6 reference to the amount of money expended therefor, and the  
7 plan for the development and future expansion of said facili-  
8 ties together with estimates of expenditures necessary to  
9 implement such plan. Said committee shall be provided with  
10 quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings,  
11 may travel within the commonwealth, and may expend for  
12 clerical, legal and other services and expenses such sums as  
13 may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall file a re-  
14 port of the results of its investigation and study with the clerk  
15 of the senate on or before June first, nineteen hundred and  
16 sixty-seven.
