## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK TO INDEMNIFY THE CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE ROXBURY DISTRICT AGAINST CERTAIN LOSSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,  
2 the county of Suffolk may pay not exceeding nine thousand  
3 three hundred sixty-nine dollars and thirty cents to the chief  
4 probation officer of the municipal court of the Roxbury dis-  
5 trict to indemnify him for losses sustained by larceny on  
6 December third, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and again  
7 on January tenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and by  
8 burglary on February fifteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-  
9 four. If after such payment such officer receives any sum in  
10 reduction of such losses, he shall forthwith pay over the same  
11 to said county of Suffolk.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

4. The various divisions are headed by Division Chiefs, who are responsible for the work of their respective divisions.
5. The Department of Education is a part of the Executive Branch of the Government and is subject to the control of the President.
6. The Department of Education is a non-profit organization and its funds are derived from the Federal Government.
7. The Department of Education is a permanent organization and its work is continuous.
8. The Department of Education is a public organization and its work is for the benefit of the people.
9. The Department of Education is a national organization and its work is for the benefit of the entire country.
