AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT WHICH MAY BE GRANTED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE UNDER A SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
