RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING A DEDUCTION FROM THE PENSIONS OF RETIRED SCHOOL TEACHERS FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN INSURANCE PREMIUMS.

1 *Resolved*, That the group insurance commission investigate
2 and study the subject matter of current senate document
3 numbered 615, relative to authorizing a deduction for pay-
4 ment of premiums for hospitalization, medical and surgical
5 insurance from pensions of retired school teachers. Said com-
6 mission shall report to the general court the results of its
7 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
10 the senate on or before the last Wednesday of January, nine-
11 teen hundred and sixty-eight.
