The committee on Bills in the Third Reading, to whom was referred the Senate Bill insuring that practical training under the supervision of any registered architect will qualify as that experience required for registration (Senate, No. 1143), reports recommending that the same be amended by substituting therefor a new draft entitled "An Act providing that employment in a certain training program under the supervision of a registered architect will count towards office training experience required for examination for registration as an architect" (Senate, No. 1183), and that, when so amended, the same will be correctly drawn.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EMPLOYMENT IN A CERTAIN TRAINING PROGRAM UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A REGISTERED ARCHITECT WILL COUNT TOWARDS OFFICE TRAINING EXPERIENCE REQUIRED FOR EXAMINATION FOR REGISTRATION AS AN ARCHITECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 60C of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended by chapter 94 of the acts of 1962, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 The practical training in offices of registered architects re-
- 5 quired under this section may be satisfied in part by con-
- 6 secutive employment for a period of not less than one year
- 7 under a training program which is approved by the board,
- 8 supervised by a registered architect, and established by a local
- 9 planning board, formed under general or special law and
- 10 which, as part of its duties, prepares design plans for the city
- 11 or town, and reviews and approves architectural work sub-
- 12 mitted by registered architects; provided, that not more than
- 13 eighteen months of such employment shall be credited as such
- 14 practical office training.
