## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM TAXATION BUILDINGS OWNED BY NON-PROFIT CORPORATIONS AND USED EXCLUSIVELY IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF CEMETERIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out clause Twelfth, as amended by chap-  
3 ter 262 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following clause: —

5 Twelfth, Cemeteries, tombs and rights of burial, so long as  
6 dedicated to the burial of the dead, and buildings owned by  
7 religious or nonprofit corporations and used exclusively in the  
8 administration of such cemeteries, tombs and rights of burial.
