AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUFFOLK COUNTY TO CONSTRUCT A NEW COURT HOUSE IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing suitable and ade-
2 quate facilities for the district court of Chelsea in the county
3 of Suffolk the city of Boston is hereby authorized to construct
4 on premises now occupied by said district court a new district
5 court house with suitable quarters and other facilities for said
6 court, and to furnish and equip the same.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act the treasurer of the
2 city of Boston, in his capacity as treasurer of Suffolk county,
3 may borrow upon the credit of said county such sums, not
4 exceeding one million dollars, as may be necessary, and may
5 issue bonds of the county therefor which shall bear on their
6 face the words, Chelsea District Court House Loan, Act of 1968.
7 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and
8 such loans shall be payable not more than ten years from their
9 dates. The said bonds shall be signed by said treasurer and
10 countersigned by a majority of the members of the city council
11 of the city of Boston. The county may sell said bonds at public
12 or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as said city
13 council may deem proper, but for not less than their par value.
14 Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein pro-
15 vided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.
