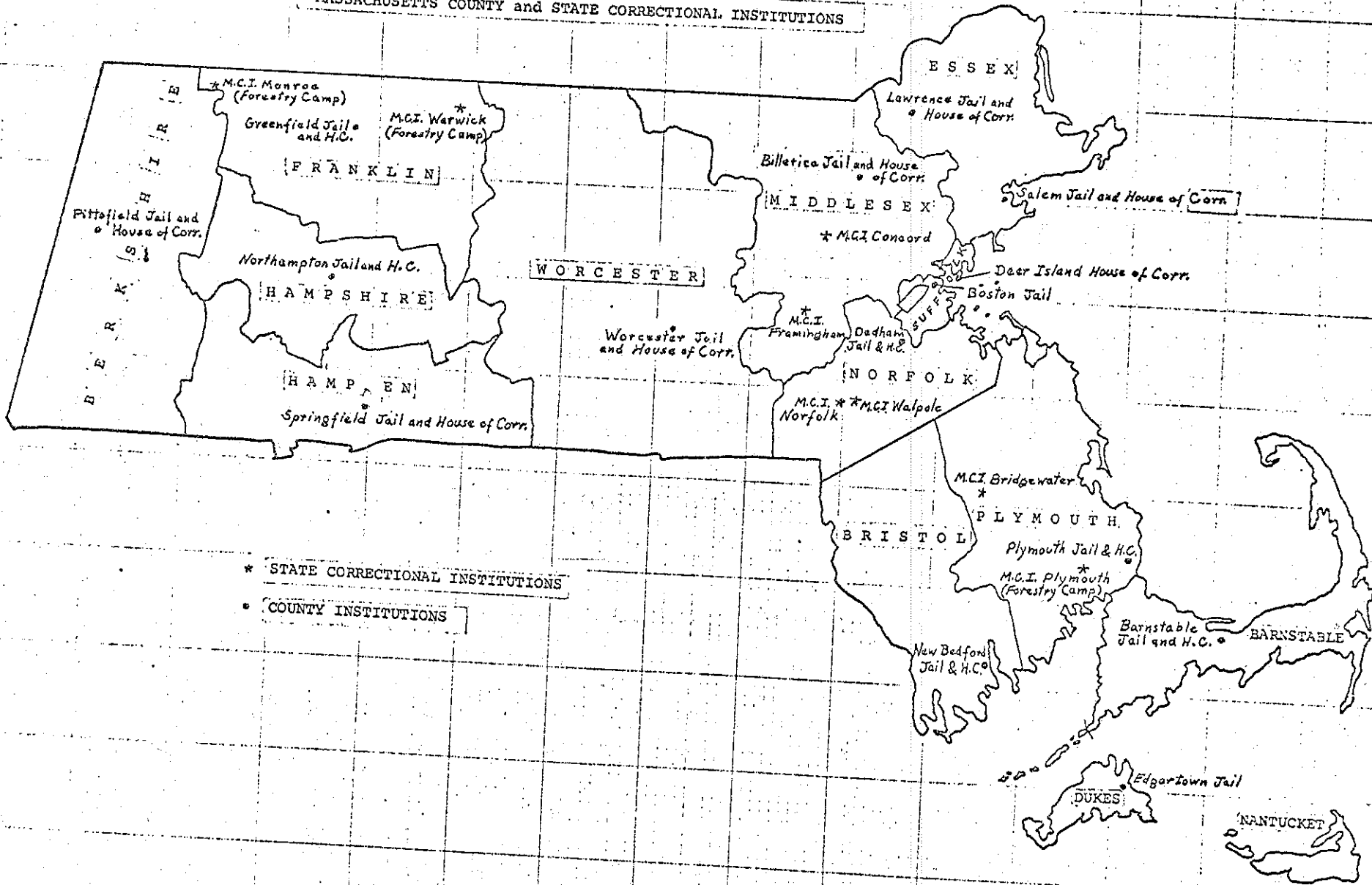

ALL COUNTY JAILS AND HOUSES OF CORRECTION ARE UNDER THE GENERAL SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION BUT ARE DIRECTLY ADMINISTERED BY COUNTY OFFICERS. THE FACILITIES FOR JUVENILE DELINQUENTS ARE UNDER THE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

THE ANNUAL REPORTS OF THE SUPERINTENDENTS OF MASSACHUSETTS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS AT BRIDGEWATER, CONCORD, FRAMINGHAM, NORFOLK AND WALPOLE AND THE DIRECTOR OF PRISON CAMPS AT MONROE, PLYMOUTH AND WARWICK ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THIS DOCUMENT. THESE REPORTS ARE ON FILE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION AND THE STATE LIBRARY.

IN THIS REPORT ALL THE FINANCIAL TABLES CONCERNING THE STATE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS RELATE TO THE YEAR THAT ENDED ON JUNE 30, 1972 IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN ACT OF 1941 THAT ESTABLISHED A FISCAL YEAR.
