RESOLUTIONS

Relative to the Entering of Specifications by the Boston Navy Yard for the Repair of the United States Ship "Leviathan."

1 *Whereas*, The United States shipping board is about
2 to open bids for the repair and reconstruction of the
3 United States ship Leviathan; and

4 *Whereas*, The Boston navy yard on previous occasion
5 has filed specifications and bid for the repair work on
6 said ship; and

7 *Whereas*, This bid of the Boston navy yard was con-
8 siderably lower than other competitive bids; and

9 *Whereas*, In order to complete the repairs on said ship
10 the work must be done in the dry dock at Boston; there-
11 fore be it

12 *Resolved*, That the senate and house of representatives
13 petition the United States shipping board and the United
14 States navy department, requesting that the Boston

15 navy yard be permitted to enter specifications for the
16 repair of said ship Leviathan, and that copies of these
17 resolutions be sent to the president of the United States,
18 the vice-president of the United States, the secretary of
19 the navy, the United States shipping board, and the
20 senators and representatives in congress from the com-
21 monwealth of Massachusetts.
