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Substituted by amendment by the Senate (Dahlborg) for the House report of the committee on Military Affairs, reference to the next annual session, on the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 302) of the Massachusetts Association of Assessors for the repeal of the provisions of the militia law relative to assessors' lists for enrolment.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two.

### AN ACT

Relative to Assessors' Lists for Enrolment in the Militia.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty-three of the General Laws is  
2 amended by striking out section six and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following:— *Section 6.* As-  
4 sessors shall annually, in April or May, make a  
5 report of the number of persons living within their  
6 respective limits liable to enrolment, and shall  
7 place a certified copy thereof in the hands of the  
8 clerks of their respective towns, who shall place  
9 it on file with the records of such town, and annu-  
10 ally, in May, June or July, transmit reports of the  
11 number of militia thus enrolled to the adjutant  
12 general.
