

SENATE No. 395

To accompany the petition of Henry C. Peirce for authority to build and maintain a bridge across Nasketucket River in the town of Fairhaven. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Construction and Maintenance of a Private Bridge over Nasketucket River in Fairhaven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to the approval of the division of
2 waterways and public lands of the department
3 of public works, Henry C. Peirce of Fairhaven,
4 and his heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized
5 to construct and maintain a fixed bridge across
6 Nasketucket river in the town of Fairhaven at a
7 point about two hundred yards below the bridge
8 or culvert of the New York, New Haven and
9 Hartford Railroad Company over said river.
