To accompany the petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees, by F. J. Dowd, president, that provision be made for the payment of pensions to widows of laborers who have been in public employ. Social Welfare.

An Act providing for the Payment of Pensions to the Widows of Laborers who have been in Public Employ.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section seventy-seven
3 the following new section:—

4 *Section 77A.* Upon the decease of a person re-
5 ceiving a pension under the preceding section, the
6 same shall be paid to his widow during the period
7 of her widowhood.
