

To accompany the petition of William J. Francis that a special commission be appointed to make arrangements for an appropriate observance of the one hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the Battle of Bunker Hill. Joint Ways and Means.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

Resolve providing for the Observance of the One Hundred and Fiftieth Anniversary of the Battle of Bunker Hill.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, consist-
2 ing of one senator to be designated by the presi-
3 dent of the senate, four representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker of the house of repre-
5 sentatives, and three persons to be appointed
6 by the governor, is hereby established for the
7 purpose of arranging an appropriate patriotic
8 programme for the proper observance of the
9 one hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the
10 Battle of Bunker Hill, which anniversary will
11 occur on the seventeenth of June in the current
12 year. For said purpose the commission may
13 expend such sums, not exceeding twenty-five
14 thousand dollars, as may be appropriated by
15 the general court, with the approval of the gov-
16 ernor and council.
