The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act establishing the Salary of the Director of the Division of Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section six of chapter twenty-
2 one of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out in the seventh line the words “ four
4 thousand ” and inserting in place thereof the
5 words: — forty-five hundred, — so as to read as
6 follows: — *Section 6.* Upon the expiration of
7 the term of office of a director of the division
8 of fisheries and game, his successor shall, except
9 as provided by section three, be appointed for
10 three years by the governor, with the advice
11 and consent of the council. The director shall
12 be qualified by training and experience to per-
13 form the duties of his office, and shall, except as
14 provided by section three, receive such salary,
15 not exceeding forty-five hundred dollars, as the
16 governor and council determine. The director
17 shall be allowed necessary travel expenses for

18 himself and his employees incurred in the dis-
19 charge of duty.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect
2 until sufficient appropriation has been made
3 therefor, and then as of June first in the cur-
4 rent year.
