

To accompany the petition of William I. Hennessey that the city of Boston be authorized to pension Richard A. Friel. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act Authorizing the City of Boston to pay a Pension to Richard A. Friel.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may pay
2 Richard A. Friel, an employee of the county of
3 Suffolk, who was accidentally injured in the per-
4 formance of his duty on January eleventh, nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-two, an annual pension
6 equal to the amount to which he would be en-
7 titled for accidental disability under the provisions
8 of chapter five hundred and twenty-one of the
9 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two. Said
10 pension shall be payable from the funds of the
11 retirement system established by said chapter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of the city
3 of Boston, subject to the provisions of its charter;
4 provided, that such acceptance occurs prior to
5 December thirty-first in the current year.
