

SENATE No. 262

To accompany the petition of Edward J. Cox that the city of Chelsea be authorized to reinstate Adolph E. Anderberg as a permanent member of its fire department. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act authorizing the City of Chelsea to Reinstate Adolph E. Anderberg as a Permanent Member of Its Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Chelsea may reinstate
2 Adolph E. Anderberg as a permanent member of
3 the fire department of said city without further
4 civil service examination, in recognition of the
5 satisfactory and loyal service rendered by him
6 from July thirty-one, nineteen hundred and nine
7 to December twenty-three, nineteen hundred and
8 twelve, when he resigned from said department
9 because of illness.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the board of aldermen of
3 said city, subject to the provisions of its charter;
4 provided, that such acceptance occurs prior to
5 December thirty-first in the current year.
