

SENATE No. 293

To accompany the petition of John G. Holmes and others, selectmen, that certain nominations of town officers in the town of Saugus be validated. Towns.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act to validate Certain Nominations of Town Officers in the Town of Saugus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All nominations of candidates for
2 town offices in the town of Saugus to be filled at
3 the annual town meeting in the current year
4 made by nomination papers which have been
5 filed and accepted by, or shall hereafter be filed
6 with, the town clerk in conformity with section
7 ten of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws,
8 as amended by chapter three hundred and
9 eighty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and
10 twenty-one, if and in so far as such nominations
11 may be invalid by reason of being submitted to
12 the registrars for the purpose of having the
13 signatures thereon certified, in accordance with
14 the provisions of section seven of said chapter
15 fifty-three, as amended by section one of chapter
16 two hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen

17 hundred and twenty-two, instead of in accordance
18 with the provisions of said section, as finally
29 amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-
20 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
21 three, are hereby made valid.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
