## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

---

An Act relative to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs in Attendance upon the Supreme Judicial Court, Superior or Probate Court or upon the Session of the County Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section seventy-five of chapter two hundred  
2 and twenty-one of the General Laws as amended  
3 by chapter four hundred and twenty-three of  
4 the acts of one thousand nine hundred and  
5 twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking  
6 out section seventy-five and inserting in place  
7 thereof the following new section:—

8 *Section 75.* Deputy sheriffs not on salary shall  
9 be paid ten dollars a day for attendance upon the  
10 supreme judicial, superior or probate court, or  
11 upon the session of the county commissioners,  
12 and ten cents a mile for travel out and home  
13 once a week during such attendance. Con-  
14 stables shall be paid for such attendance four

15 dollars a day, and five cents a mile for travel  
16 out and home once a week, except that when in  
17 attendance upon the supreme judicial court in  
18 Suffolk county they shall receive four dollars  
19 and fifty cents a day. Compensation under this  
20 section shall be paid by the respective counties,  
21 except that for attendance on the supreme ju-  
22 dicial court in Suffolk county when said court is  
23 sitting for the commonwealth it shall be paid by  
24 the commonwealth.
