To accompany the petition of Walter T. Rochefort, mayor, and members of the city council, that the city of Lawrence be authorized to maintain an athletic field to which admission may be charged. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act relative to the Maintenance of an Athletic Field in the City of Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The director of the department of public
2 property of the city of Lawrence, under the
3 direction of its city council, may maintain an
4 athletic field, with suitable equipment, on land
5 on Osgood street and Winthrop avenue, owned
6 by the city and now known as Memorial park,
7 and may permit the use of said field for ath-
8 letic games and other entertainments of a public
9 nature, at which an admission fee may be charged,
10 to such person or persons and upon such condi-
11 tions as may be fixed by the said director, with
12 the approval of the city council.
