

SENATE No. 223

To accompany the petition of Lawrence F. Quigley, mayor of the city of Chelsea, that the term of office of the mayor of said city be established. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act establishing the Term of Office of the Mayor
of the City of Chelsea.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six of part two of chapter six hundred
2 and eighty of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 eleven is hereby amended by striking out said
4 section and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing: —

6 *Section 6.* At the annual city election in the
7 year nineteen hundred and twenty-six and in
8 each even-numbered year thereafter, there shall
9 be elected by and from the qualified voters of
10 the city a mayor who shall hold office for two
11 years and until his successor is elected and quali-
12 fied, except that when elected to fill a vacancy he
13 shall hold office only for the unexpired term and
14 until his successor is elected and qualified.
