The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act providing for the Judicial Enforcement of the Duty of the Mayor of the City of Cambridge to fill Vacancies in the Office of City Treasurer in said City.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor of the city of Cambridge
2 shall fill any vacancy in the office of treasurer of
3 said city, and upon rejection by the city council of
4 said city of any person appointed by the mayor to
5 fill such a vacancy, the mayor shall, within one
6 month thereafter, appoint another person. Com-
7 pliance by the mayor with any provisions of this
8 act shall be enforceable by writ of mandamus in
9 the supreme judicial or superior court upon petition
10 of not less than ten taxable inhabitants of said
11 city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city;
3 provided, that such acceptance occurs during the
4 current year.
