Accompanying the recommendation of the Board of Registration in Medicine (House, No. 57). State Administration. Dec. 2, 1926.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Appointment of an Investigator by the Board of Registration in Medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The board of registration in medicine shall appoint
2 an investigator of violations of the medical laws and,
3 with the approval of the governor and council, shall
4 fix his salary. He shall be allowed his necessary travel-
5 ing expenses while actually engaged in his professional
6 duties. He shall make his investigations under instruc-
7 tions of the said board and shall report to the board his
8 findings in each case.
