Accompanying the second recommendation of the Department of Public Utilities (House, No. 79). Power and Light. Dec. 2, 1926.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Joint Use of Pole Locations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after section twenty-two
3 the following new section:—

4 *Section 22A.* The department, upon petition of the
5 board of aldermen of a city, or the selectmen of a town
6 wherein a pole line carrying wires for the transmission of
7 intelligence by electricity, or for the transmission of elec-
8 tricity for light, heat or power, or used in connection
9 with the operation of a street railway or railroad, is lo-
10 cated may, after a hearing, require the attachment of
11 other wires belonging to a telephone, telegraph, electric,
12 street railway or railroad company to the poles or other
13 supports of said pole line, or may require the reconstruc-
14 tion of said pole line in order that it may sustain such
15 wires upon such terms, regulations and conditions as the
16 department may deem just and reasonable.
