## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

---

An Act relative to the Revocation by the Town of Milton of Reservations of Special Spaces for the Use of Street Railways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and  
2 twenty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred  
3 and ninety-five is hereby amended by inserting  
4 therein, after section three, the following sec-  
5 tions 3A and 3B: —

6 *Section 3A.* The reservation of any special  
7 space for the use of street railways, under the  
8 provisions of this act, may from time to time  
9 be revoked in whole or in part by the vote of  
10 a majority of the voters voting thereon at a  
11 town meeting called for the purpose. Such  
12 vote shall designate by description sufficient  
13 for identification the space as to which such  
14 reservation is revoked. Such vote shall be  
15 passed in open town meeting and need not be  
16 placed upon the official ballot.

17 *Section 3B.* Upon such revocation the pro-  
18 visions of this act shall cease to apply to that  
19 part of such special reserved space as to which  
20 the reservation is revoked. Revocation as  
21 above provided shall not affect the validity of  
22 any location theretofore granted to street rail-  
23 ways, but such location may be altered in ac-  
24 cordance with the provisions of section seventy-  
25 one of chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the  
26 General Laws and acts in amendment thereof  
27 and addition thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon  
2 its passage.
