Resolve providing for a Study and Report by the Commissioner of Civil Service on the Working of the Civil Service Laws and Rules relative to the Labor Service in the City of Fall River.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioner of civil service
2 is hereby directed to make a study of the registra-
3 tion and selection of employees of the city of Fall
4 River in the labor service, and to report to the
5 general court the results of his study, with recom-
6 mendations for such changes in the rules relative
7 to such service or otherwise as would improve the
8 working of the civil service laws and rules relative
9 to the labor service in said city, by filing the same
10 with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
11 before April first in the current year.
