

By Mr. Dean of Chilmark, petition of Otis B. Luce and others that jurisdiction over certain tide waters be ceded to the town of West Tisbury. Harbors and Public Lands. Jan. 6.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act to cede to the Town of West Tisbury Jurisdiction over its Tide Waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Jurisdiction over the tide waters in
2 the Atlantic ocean south of Marthas Vineyard
3 island, granted to the town of Tisbury under the
4 provisions of chapter one hundred and ninety-six
5 of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, is
6 hereby ceded to the town of West Tisbury.

1 SECTION 2. Jurisdiction over the tide waters of
2 Vineyard sound lying westerly of an extension
3 northerly of the boundary line between the towns
4 of Tisbury and West Tisbury, established by
5 chapter two hundred and sixteen of the acts of
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-two and granted to
7 the town of Tisbury under the provisions of chapter
8 one hundred and ninety-six of the acts of eighteen
9 hundred and eighty-one, is hereby ceded to the
10 town of West Tisbury.
