

By Mr. Spear of Everett, petition of Blaine Sweatt for legislation to abolish the office of chief of inspections in the Department of Public Safety and for the creation of certain other offices in said department. State Administration. Jan. 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act to abolish the Office of Chief of Inspections and to create Certain Offices in the Department of Public Safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of chief of inspections, of the
2 department of public safety, is hereby abolished.

1 SECTION 2. The office of chief inspector of boilers, of
2 the department of public safety, is hereby created.

1 SECTION 3. The office of chief inspector of buildings,
2 of the department of public safety, is hereby created.

1 SECTION 4. The governor is hereby authorized and
2 directed to appoint one member of the boiler inspection
3 division of the department of public safety as chief in-
4 spector of boilers of said division, at a salary of four
5 thousand dollars per annum, and all actual and necessary
6 expenses and any vacancies which may hereafter occur
7 in said office of chief inspector of boilers shall be filled in
8 the same manner. Said chief inspector of boilers shall
9 have jurisdiction over the members of the said boiler

10 inspection division, and he shall take charge of all docu-
11 ments and properties, and take over all the authority,
12 and perform all the duties now held and performed by
13 the chief of inspections, hereby abolished, in connection
14 with the work of the said boiler inspection division, and
15 he shall be directly responsible to the commissioner of
16 public safety for the proper performance of his duties.

1 SECTION 5. The chief inspector of boilers shall act as
2 chairman of the board of boiler rules.

1 SECTION 6. The governor is hereby authorized and
2 directed to appoint one member of the building inspec-
3 tion division of the department of public safety, as chief
4 inspector of buildings of said division, at a salary of four
5 thousand dollars per annum, and all actual and neces-
6 sary expenses and any vacancies which may hereafter
7 occur in said office of chief inspector of buildings shall be
8 filled in the same manner. Said chief inspector of build-
9 ings shall have jurisdiction over the members of the said
10 building inspection division, and he shall take charge of
11 all documents and properties, and take over all authority,
12 and perform all the duties now held and performed by
13 the chief of inspections, hereby abolished, in connection
14 with the work of the said building inspection division,
15 and he shall be directly responsible to the commissioner
16 of public safety for the proper performance of his duties.

1 SECTION 7. The tenure of office and rights to pension,
2 of the chief inspector of boilers and the chief inspectors
3 of buildings shall be the same as they held as members of
4 the department of public safety.

1 SECTION 8. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.
