## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Publication of Written Notice of the Time and Place of a Proposed Sale on Execution.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section twenty-eight of chapter two hundred  
2 thirty-six of the General Laws is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the word "town" in  
4 the eighth line and inserting in place thereof  
5 the word:—county,—so that said section  
6 when amended shall read as follows:—*Section*  
7 28. The officer, thirty days at least before the  
8 sale, shall deliver to the debtor, if found within  
9 his precinct, a written notice of the time and  
10 place of sale and shall post such a notice in a  
11 public place in the town where the land lies and  
12 also in two adjoining towns, if there are so  
13 many in the county. The officer shall also pub-  
14 lish such a notice once in each of three succes-  
15 sive weeks, the first publication to be not less  
16 than twenty-one days before the day of sale, in  
17 a newspaper published in the county where the  
18 land lies.
