By Mr. Charles S. Sullivan, Jr., of Boston, petition of David M. Cleary that the city of Boston be authorized to reinstate him as a member of its fire department without further examination. Civil Service. Jan. 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the Reinstatement of David M. Cleary as a Member of the Boston Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. David M. Cleary, formerly a
2 member of the Boston fire department, and
3 who was discharged therefrom on September
4 fourth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, may
5 be reinstated in said department without
6 further examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its acceptance by the mayor and city council
3 of said city, in accordance with the provisions
4 of its charter, provided said acceptance occurs
5 prior to December thirty-first of the current
6 year.
