## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act to extend the Corporate Powers of the Trustees of Groton School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section three of chapter ninety-four of the acts of  
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-three, as amended by  
3 chapter two hundred and eight of the acts of nineteen  
4 hundred and three and by chapter ninety-two of the  
5 acts of nineteen hundred and fourteen, and chapter two  
6 hundred and sixty of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
7 twenty, is hereby further amended by striking out the  
8 word "three" in the twelfth line and substituting the  
9 word:— five,— so as to read as follows:— *Section 3.*  
10 Said corporation is hereby authorized to take and re-  
11 ceive by gift, grant, bequest, devise or otherwise, any  
12 lands, tenements or other estate, real and personal, to  
13 have and to hold the same upon the terms and for the  
14 purposes specified in the declaration of trust aforesaid;  
15 and also upon such terms and for such purposes and  
16 trusts as may be expressed in any deed or instrument of  
17 conveyance or gift made to said corporation; provided,

18 the same shall not be inconsistent with the terms and  
 19 purposes of the declaration of trust aforesaid, made and  
 20 declared by said trustees; and provided, the real and  
 21 personal estate held by said corporation shall not ex-  
 22 ceed in value five million dollars.
