## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the Reinstatement of Thomas J. Monahan in the Public Works Department of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Thomas J. Monahan, formerly a stenog-  
2 rapher and clerk in the public works department of the  
3 city of Boston, and who resigned therefrom on June  
4 twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred and eighteen, may be  
5 reinstated in said department without further examina-  
6 tion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-  
2 ance by the mayor and city council of said city, in  
3 accordance with the provisions of its charter; provided,  
4 that said acceptance occurs during the current year.
