Resolve relative to the Amount of the Bonds required on each Contract for the Printing and Sale of Advance Copies of Opinions of the Supreme Judicial Court.

1 *Resolved*, That the bonds to secure the faithful per-
2 formance of each contract or part thereof, for the print-
3 ing and sale to the public of advance copies of opinions
4 of the supreme judicial court, which the attorney general,
5 the secretary of the commonwealth and the reporter of
6 decisions are authorized, under the provisions of chapter
7 forty of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-six,
8 to negotiate for and execute shall be in an amount not
9 less than one thousand dollars, and any party having
10 given a bond or bonds to an amount not less than ten
11 thousand dollars upon any such contract shall give, in
12 substitution therefor, a new bond or bonds, satisfactory
13 to the said officers, to an amount not less than one thou-
14 sand dollars, in which event any such bond or bonds
15 heretofore given shall be cancelled.
