Mr. Holmes of Brockton presented a petition of the mayor and city solicitor that the city of Brockton be authorized to collect fees for elevator inspections and the issue of certificates therefor. Cities. February 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the City of Brockton to establish and collect Fees for Elevator Inspections by its Building Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Brockton
2 is hereby authorized to establish by ordinance a fee
3 sufficient to cover the cost of each elevator inspection
4 made by its building department under the provisions of
5 sections sixty-two to sixty-five, inclusive, of chapter one
6 hundred and forty-three of the General Laws, but not
7 exceeding in each case the sum of dollars.
8 Said fee shall be collected by the building inspector of
9 said city before issuing the certificate described in section
10 sixty-five of said chapter and the same shall be paid into
11 the treasury of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by vote of the city council of said city, subject to
3 the provisions of its charter; provided, that such ac-
4 ceptance occurs during the current year.
