In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the City of Taunton to pay the Claim of Agnes A. Winston for Injuries caused by its Fire Apparatus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the city of Taunton may pay to Agnes A.
3 Winston for injuries caused by its fire apparatus on or
4 about January twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-six, in consequence of negligence in the manage-
6 ment of said apparatus, the sum of two thousand dollars,
7 payable sixteen dollars weekly. Said payment shall be
8 in full compensation on the part of said city on account
9 of said injuries.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by vote of the municipal council of said city, sub-
3 ject to the provisions of its charter; provided, that such
4 acceptance occurs during the current year.
