In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Taxation of the Property of Wellesley College.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter two hundred and sixty-seven
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is
3 hereby amended by striking out all after the word
4 "dollars" in the fourth line, and inserting in place
5 thereof the following:—and the real and personal
6 estate so held shall be exempt from taxation to the
7 extent provided by general law", — so that said section
8 shall read:—*Section 1.* Wellesley College is hereby
9 authorized to hold real and personal estate in the
10 manner and for the purposes set forth in its charter to
11 an amount not exceeding twenty million dollars, and
12 the real and personal estate so held shall be exempt
13 from taxation to the extent provided by General Law.
