The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act relative to Sittings of the Second District Court of Southern Worcester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two
2 hundred and eighteen of the General Laws,
3 as amended by section one of chapter four
4 hundred and thirty of the acts of nineteen
5 hundred and twenty-one, by section one of
6 chapter two hundred and forty-three of the
7 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-three and
8 by section one of chapter two hundred and
9 twenty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred
10 and twenty-four, is hereby further amended
11 by inserting after the word " Uxbridge " the
12 first time it occurs in the one hundred and
13 eighty-seventh line as printed in the General
14 Laws the words:—, and at Northbridge in
15 that part thereof called Whitinsville,—so
16 that the paragraph contained in the one hun-

17 dred and eighty-sixth and one hundred and
18 eighty-seventh lines as printed as aforesaid will
19 read as follows:—The second district court
20 of southern Worcester, held at Blackstone and
21 Uxbridge, and at Northbridge in that part
22 thereof called Whitinsville; Blackstone, Ux-
23 bridge, Douglas, Northbridge and Millville.

1 SECTION 2. The second district court of
2 southern Worcester shall be held for criminal
3 business in Uxbridge on Monday and Thurs-
4 day, in Blackstone on Tuesday and Friday
5 and in that part of Northbridge called Whit-
6 insville on Wednesday and Saturday, and for
7 civil business in said Whitinsville on Satur-
8 day, in each week, except on legal holidays,
9 and at such other times as may be fixed ac-
10 cording to law.

1 SECTION 3. So much of chapter two hun-
2 dred and one of the acts of eighteen hundred
3 and seventy-two and acts in amendment thereof
4 and in addition thereto as is inconsistent here-
5 with is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
