Resolve providing for the Further Investigation of the
Advisability of filling in Part of the Fort Point Channel
and South Bay in Boston Harbor.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioner of public works, the
2 commissioners of public health, the chairman of the
3 division of metropolitan planning and the chairman of
4 the Boston city planning board are hereby constituted
5 a special commission to further investigate the filling
6 of the present navigable waters of that part of the Fort
7 Point Channel and South Bay lying above Dorchester
8 Avenue bridge and matters incidental and related thereto
9 as provided for in chapter fifty of the resolves of the
10 year nineteen hundred and twenty-six. Said commission
11 may expend for the purposes of this resolve such sum
12 not exceeding twenty thousand dollars as may be ap-
13 propriated by the general court. The city of Boston
14 shall reimburse the commonwealth for one half of the
15 expense incurred under said appropriation, and the state
16 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to assess the
17 same upon said city under the statutes providing for
18 the collection of state taxes. Said commission shall
19 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
20 tions and its recommendations, if any, together with
21 drafts of legislation to carry the same into effect, by
22 filing the same with the clerk of the house of represen-
23 tatives on or before December first, nineteen hundred
24 and twenty-eight.
