1 *Resolved*, That after an appropriation has been made,
2 the commissioner of public safety is hereby directed to
3 collate and cause to be printed in pamphlet form not
4 exceeding three thousand copies of the laws of the
5 commonwealth relating to fires and fire departments.
6 Said copies shall be distributed, upon request, to such
7 public officials as the commissioner may designate.
