Resolve to reimburse the New Bedford Textile School for  
the Loss of Certain Moneys of said School by Theft.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth from the appropriation  
3 made by item three hundred and seventy-eight of the  
4 general appropriation act of the present year the sum of  
5 one hundred forty-eight dollars and twenty-four cents  
6 to the principal of the New Bedford textile school for the  
7 use of said school, and to reimburse it for the loss of an  
8 equal amount by thefts on June fifteenth and September  
9 tenth, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.
