

Mr. Nutting of Leominster presented a petition of the mayor of the city of Leominster and the selectmen of the town of Lunenburg that said city be authorized to construct an outfall sewer through certain sections of said town to the filtration beds of the city of Fitchburg in said town. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act to provide for the Disposal of the Sewage from the Northerly Part of the City of Leominster.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of collecting and dis-
2 posing of the sewage from the northerly part of the
3 city of Leominster, said city may lay out, construct and
4 maintain a sewer with an outlet into that part of the
5 sewage disposal works of the city of Fitchburg located
6 in the town of Lunenburg in case said cities mutually
7 agree thereto, otherwise with such outlet as may be
8 determined by said city of Leominster with the ap-
9 proval of the department of public health; provided,
10 that no works shall be constructed hereunder until plans
11 of said sewer have been approved by said department.
12 For the aforesaid purpose said city of Leominster may
13 take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of
14 the General Laws, or acquire by purchase or otherwise,
15 such lands, water rights, rights of way and easements in
16 said city as may be deemed necessary for the establish-
17 ment of such a system of sewerage and sewage disposal

18 and for any connections therewith, and may so take or
19 acquire a strip of land in said town of such width as
20 may be deemed necessary extending along or near the
21 southerly and westerly shores of Whalom lake from a
22 point on the boundary line between the said city of
23 Leominster and said town near said southerly shore of
24 said lake to a point on said boundary line at or near
25 where Wilder avenue crosses it; and, in case the said
26 city and the city of Fitchburg mutually agree to the
27 connection of such sewer with the sewage disposal works
28 as aforesaid, may also so take or acquire another strip
29 of land in said town of such width as may be deemed
30 necessary extending from a point on said boundary line
31 at or near the end of Summer street in said town south-
32 erly through said town to a point at or near that part
33 of the sewage disposal works of said city of Fitchburg
34 located in said town. Any person whose property is
35 injured by any action of said city of Leominster here-
36 under may recover damages from said city under said
37 chapter seventy-nine. For the aforesaid purpose, said
38 city of Leominster may lay sewers through or under
39 private and other lands, water courses and under any
40 way, street railway or railroad, and for the aforesaid
41 purpose or for repairing such sewers may enter upon and
42 dig up such private or other lands, ways, street railways
43 or railroads, in such manner as not unnecessarily to
44 obstruct the same; provided, that said city of Leominster
45 shall not do any of the aforesaid work within the location
46 of any railroad corporation except at such time and in
47 such manner as it may agree upon with such corporation
48 or, in case of failure so to agree, as may be approved by
49 the department of public utilities. Said city of
50 Leominster shall leave any way so dug up in said town
51 in a condition satisfactory to the selectmen of said town.

52 Said city of Leominster and said city of Fitchburg are
53 hereby authorized to contract for the disposal of the
54 sewage aforesaid tributary to the sewer herein provided
55 for upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually
56 agreed upon.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
