EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, Boston, April 8, 1927.

*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:*

Under the provisions of Article LVI. of the Amendments to the Constitution, I am returning herewith House Bill No. 1183, entitled "An Act Providing for the Construction of a New Highway from Charles River Dam to Nashua Street and the Widening of said Street and Causeway Street in the City of Boston", with the recommendation that it be amended as follows:

By striking out in Section two, fourth line, the words "two hundred thousand".

The benefits accruing to interested parties are so obviously great that it is my feeling that the city should not be given authority to spend over a million dollars on this project.
