

By Mr. Stone of Wayland, petition of the selectmen of the town of Weston that said town be authorized to establish a World War Trust Fund and provide for the expenditure of the income therefrom. Towns. April 8.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the Town of Weston to Establish and Maintain a World War Trust Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Weston is hereby authorized
2 to establish and maintain a World War Trust Fund to
3 consist of the War Bonus Fund and the Public Safety
4 Fund now held by said town and designated by said
5 titles on its books. Said World War Trust Fund shall be
6 held by said town under the general provisions of law
7 relative to trust funds. The income thereof may annu-
8 ally be expended under the direction of the selectmen of
9 said town to defray in whole or in part the expenses
10 incident to the celebration of memorial day including the
11 decoration of the graves of sailors, soldiers and marines
12 of the United States. Any income not so used to be
13 added to the principal of said fund. Said town is also
14 authorized to receive gifts which may be added to said
15 fund.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
