Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Corporations and Taxation as to Certain Problems Relating to Municipal Finances and Betterment Assessments.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of corporations and
2 taxation is hereby authorized and directed to study and
3 investigate the recommendations contained in the in-
4 augural address of his excellency the governor, printed
5 as senate document number one of the current year,
6 relating to municipal expenditures, indebtedness, audit
7 control thereof and municipal accounts and budgets,
8 and also the operation of the laws of the commonwealth
9 relative to the assessment and collection of betterments.
10 The department shall report its findings, with such
11 recommendations and drafts of such legislation as it may
12 deem expedient, to the next annual session of the general
13 court by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
14 representatives on or before December first in the cur-
15 rent year.
