The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act authorizing the City of Lowell to Appropriate and Expend a Sum of Money for the Payment of Certain Claims of the J. H. Sparks Co. for Services rendered and Materials and Supplies furnished in Providing Ambulance Services for the City of Lowell.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lowell is hereby authorized
2 to appropriate a sum of money not exceeding six thou-
3 sand dollars and may with the approval of the finance
4 commission of said city expend the same or any part
5 thereof in the payment and discharge of certain claims
6 of the J. H. Sparks Co. for services rendered and ma-
7 terials and supplies furnished in providing ambulance
8 services for the city of Lowell between January one,
9 nineteen hundred and twenty-six and April twenty,
10 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven inclusive, said
11 services having been rendered and said materials and
12 supplies having been furnished without compliance with
13 the provisions of law contained in section twenty-eight

14 or twenty-nine of chapter forty-three of the General
15 Laws, or incurred in excess of departmental appropri-
16 ations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by vote of the city council of said city, subject
3 to the provisions of its charter; provided, however,
4 that such acceptance occurs during the current fiscal
5 year.
