Resolve providing for an Investigation relative to the Taking of Water from the Charles River Basin for Fire Protection and Sale for Manufacturing Purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission
2 and the department of public health, acting jointly, are
3 hereby authorized and directed to give special consider-
4 ation to the subject matter of senate document number
5 three hundred and ten of the year nineteen hundred and
6 twenty-seven with special reference to the advisability of
7 using water from the Charles River basin for fire pro-
8 tection and sale for manufacturing purposes in the cities
9 and towns adjacent to the basin and as to the probable
10 effect of such taking of water upon the use of the basin
11 and its shores for the purposes for which it was designed,
12 and also the probable effect, if any, upon the sanitary
13 condition of the shores and waters of the basin and its
14 surroundings, together with such other matters as may
15 be pertinent thereto.

16 The joint board shall report to the general court its
17 findings and recommendations in full, together with such
18 plans and drafts of legislation as it may deem necessary
19 or desirable to carry out its recommendations, by filing
20 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives
21 not later than December first of the current year.
