The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Terms of Certain Bonds and Notes to
be Issued by the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The term of the bonds which the state
2 treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter one hun-
3 dred and eleven of the acts of the present year, making
4 additional provision for the water supply needs of the
5 metropolitan district, shall not exceed twenty years, as
6 recommended by the governor in a message to the general
7 court dated April twenty-second, nineteen hundred and
8 twenty-seven, in pursuance of section three of Article
9 LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

1 SECTION 2. The term of the notes which the state
2 treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter one hun-
3 dred and seventy-seven of the acts of the present year,
4 increasing the amount of notes authorized to be issued
5 under the provisions of chapter three hundred and thirty
6 of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, as
7 amended by chapter three hundred and sixty-nine of the
8 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six, providing for
9 the laying out and construction of a southern route to
10 accommodate traffic between Boston and territory south

11 and east thereof, shall not exceed four years, as recom-
12 mended by the governor in a message to the general
13 court dated April twenty-second, nineteen hundred and
14 twenty-seven, in pursuance of section three of Article
15 LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

1 SECTION 3. The terms of bonds which the state
2 treasurer is authorized to issue under chapter one hun-
3 dred and eighty-four of the acts of the present year,
4 authorizing the extension of the Mystic Valley main
5 sewer in the north metropolitan sewerage district, shall
6 be as follows:—one half, or two hundred twenty-five
7 thousand dollars, of the amount to be issued shall be for
8 not more than three years and mature in nineteen hun-
9 dred and thirty, and the remaining two hundred twenty-
10 five thousand dollars shall be for not more than four
11 years and mature in nineteen hundred and thirty-one,
12 as recommended by the governor in a message to the
13 general court dated April twenty-second, nineteen hun-
14 dred and twenty-seven, in pursuance of section three of
15 Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution.
16 Section forty-nine of chapter twenty-nine of the General
17 Laws shall not apply to bonds issued under authority of
18 said chapter one hundred and eighty-four.
