EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, Boston, April 26, 1927.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

Under the provisions of Article LVI. of the Amendments to the Constitution, I am returning herewith House Bill No. 969, being "An Act Relative to the Purchase of Radium by the Commonwealth and to the Use of the Same to Alleviate Distress caused by Cancer," with the recommendation that it be amended as follows:

By striking out in the first section, seventh line, as engrossed, the word "sixty" and inserting in place thereof the word "seventy"; and by striking out in the same section and beginning in the same line all after the word "appropriated".

The increase of ten thousand dollars is recommended so there may be no question but that a full gram of radium may be purchased this year. The matter of further purchase of radium may well be left for consideration to another session of the Legislature.
